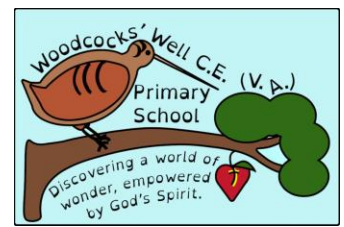


Woodcocks' Well News

St. Luke's service

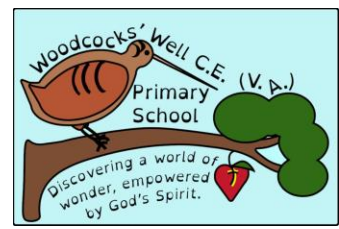
