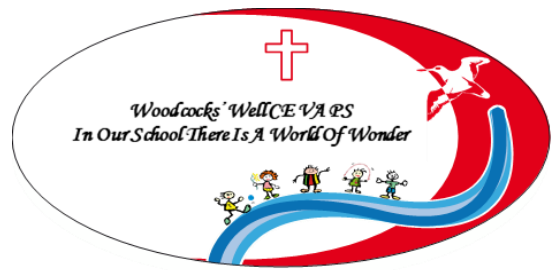


Woodcocks' Well News
